- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

Broker Statement A COMPLAINT WAS ORIGINALLY FILED IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI CIRCUIT COURT THAT NAMED ME AS A DEFENDANT, BUT THE COURT ORDERED THAT THE CLAIMS AGAINST ME AND SEVERAL OTHER DEFENDANTS BE SUBMITTED TO ARBITRATION. THE LAWSUIT THEN



PROCEEDED AGAINST CITICORP TRUST BANK. UPON FILING THE ARBITRATION, CLAIMANT DID NOT NAME ME AS A RESPONDENT OR PURSUE ANY CLAIMS AGAINST ME. THUS, AFTER THE COURT'S ORDER, I WAS NOT A PARTY TO THE LAWSUIT AND WAS NEVER A PARTY TO THE ARBITRATION. AND THUS NO DAMAGES WERE SOUGHT AGAINST ME PERSONALLY RELATED TO ANY ACTIONS TAKEN BY ME IN CONNECTION WITH THE INVESTMENTS AT ISSUE. THE LAWSUIT AND ARBITRATION WERE JOINTLY SETTLED BY THE PARTIES THEN INVOLVED (FOR A TOTAL PAYMENT OF \$400,000), BUT THE SETTLEMENT DOES NOT REFLECT ANY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OR ADMISSION OF ANY LIABILITY OR MISCONDUCT ON MY PART WHATSOEVER. I WAS NOT ASKED TO PERSONALLY CONTRIBUTE ANY AMOUNT TOWARDS THIS SETTLEMENT. THE REMAINING PARTIES RESOLVED THE MATTERS SOLELY FOR BUSINESS REASONS TO AVOID POTENTIAL COSTS AND UNCERTAINTIES OF LITIGATION.
