BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a BrokerCheck report?

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional
 qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck
 reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the
 same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.
- How current is this information?
- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. - Are there other resources I can use to check the background of investment professionals?

VIOLATIONS OF ARTICLE III, SECTIONS 1, 2 AND 27 OF THE RULES OF FAIR PRACTICE IN THAT RESPONDENT HAUSER RECOMMENDED TO A CUSTOMER THAT SHE PURCHASE STOCKS WITHOUT HAVING REASONABLE

GROUNDS FOR HIS RECOMMENDATIONS; AND, RESPONDENT MEMBER AND

UPTON FAILED TO PROPERLY SUPERVISE THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF HAUSER.

DECISION RENDERED JULY 23, 1991, CASE ID. C07890012 (ATL-1157), WHEREIN HAUSER IS CENSURED, FINED \$2,500, SUSPENDED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY MEMBER OF THE NASD IN ANY CAPACITY FOR ONE

(1) BUSINESS DAY, ORDERED TO MAKE RESTITUTION OF \$1,754 TO A CUSTOMER WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE DECISION AND PROVIDE PROOF OF PAYMENT OF SUCH RESTITUTION TO THE DISTRICT #7 OFFICE, AND ASSESSED COSTS OF \$1,066.30. THE COMMITTEE DETERMINED TO DISMISS THE COMPLAINT AGAINST RESPONDENTS MEMBER AND UPTON IN

THAT THEY DID NOT FAIL TO PROPERLY SUPERVISE RESPONDENT HAUSER

AND THAT RESPONDENT UPTON PERFORMED THE SUPERVISORY REVIEWS AND

FUNCTIONS REQUIRED OF HIM AS HAUSER'S BRANCH MANAGER.

AUGUST 7, 1991 - APPEALED TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS. NBCC DECISION RENDERED JUNE 30, 1992, WHEREIN FINDINGS MADE ARE AFFIRMED AND SANCTIONS ARE MODIFIED; HAUSER IS CENSURED, FINED \$22,427, SUSPENDED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY MEMBER OF THE NASD

IN ANY CAPACITY FOR ONE DAY, ASSESSED DBCC COSTS OF \$1,066.30 AND ASSESSED APPEAL COSTS OF \$595. HOWEVER, THE FINE MAY BE REDUCED BY ANY AMOUNTS THAT HAUSER CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT HE HAS

REPAID TO A PUBLIC CUSTOMER. JULY 14, 1992 - APPEALED TO THE SEC. 11/6/92 - THE SEC ISSUED AN ORDER WITHDRAWING REVIEW APPLICATION AND DISMISSING PROCEEDINGS AGAINST HAUSER, THEREFORE, THE NBCC DECISION IS FINAL. PRESS RELEASE DECEMBER 1992: THE SUSPENSION COMMENCES 12/21/92 AND CONCLUDES 12/21/92. **\$24.088.30 PAID ON 12/29/92 INVOICE #92-07-1055**
