About BrokerCheck®



BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.

- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:

- information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

BASED ON OUR REVIEW OF THIS MATTER, WE RESPECTFULLY DENY CLIENT'S REQUEST TO REIMBURSE THE SURRENDER CHARGES INCURRED ON THE HARTFORD LIFE (HL) ANNUITY. ON 5/3/11, A RENEWAL NOTICE WAS SENT TO THE CLIENT BY HL AND CLIENT WAS INFORMED THAT IF HE DID NOT WANT TO RENEW, HL WOULD NEED THE APPROPRIATE FORMS BY 7/7/11 TO AVOID ANY POTENTIAL WITHDRAWAL FEES OR PENALTIES. OUR INTERNAL RECORDS REFLECT CLIENT SPOKE WITH FA IN THE SPRING OF 2011 ABOUT THE ANNUITY AND IN JUNE 2011 CLIENT WAS PROVIDED WITH THE RENEWAL RATE OF 3% (RATE WAS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO CLIENT). CLIENT CONTACTED HL ON 6/16/11 AND THE RENEWAL INFO AS WELL AS W/D REQ WERE DISCUSSED. OUR RECORDS REFLECT CLIENT WALKED INTO THE BRANCH OFFICE ON 6/28/11, AND INFORMED FA HE WAS TAKING HIS MONEY TO ANOTHER FIRM. ACCORDING TO HL, CLIENT'S ANNUITY WAS EXCHANGED ON 7/21/11, OVER 3 WKS AFTER HIS WALK-IN APPOINTMENT WITH OUR FA. WE ARE UNCERTAIN WHY THERE WAS A DELAY IN EXCHANGING THE ANNUITY. LASTLY, WE ARE UNCERTAIN WHAT INVESTMENT FIRM THE CLIENT MOVED HIS ACCOUNT TO, BUT IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING A DIFFERENT FIRM REQUESTED REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE CHANGES ON AUGUST 9TH AND 11TH OF 2011 FOR THE HL POLICY. IT APPEARS THERE MAY HAVE BEEN MISCOMMUNICATION ON THE CLIENT'S INTENTIONS, AS THE REG REP CHANGES WERE REQUESTED OVER TWO WEEKS AFTER THE ANNUITY WAS EXCHANGED TO METLIFE.
