- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

Broker Statement

IN THE FALL OF 2012, MR. RICHARDSON WORKED WITH THE CLIENT TO DEVELOP A PLAN FOR SELLING CERTAIN SECURITIES TO MEET ANTICIPATED CASH NEEDS. THE PLAN WAS AFFIRMED BY THE CLIENT OVER THE TELEPHONE AND IN PERSON. IN DECEMBER 2012, MORGAN STANLEY RECEIVED A WIRE TRANSFER REQUESTS TO WITHDRAW FUNDS FROM THE CLIENT'S ACCOUNT AT ISSUE. MR. RICHARDSON EFFECTED TWO SALES OF SECURITIES, MOMENTS APART, IN THE CLIENT'S BROKERAGE ACCOUNT PURSUANT TO THE PLAN THEY HAD PREVIOUSLY DISCUSSED. AFTER THE POSITIONS WERE SOLD, MR. RICHARDSON REPORTED THE SALES TO THE CLIENT AND THE CLIENT AFFIRMED THE TRANSACTIONS AT ISSUE. DESPITE THE FACT THAT THE SALES WERE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED AND LATER AFFIRMED BY THE CLIENT, FINRA BEGAN AN INVESTIGATION IN TO THE MATTER NEARLY TWO YEARS AFTER THE TRANSACTIONS WERE EXECUTED.
