BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a BrokerCheck report?

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional
 qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck
 reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the
 same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.
- How current is this information?
- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. - Are there other resources I can use to check the background of investment professionals?
- FINRA recommends that you learn as much as possible about an investment professional before deciding
 to work with them. Your state securities regulator can help you research brokers and investment adviser
 representatives doing business in your state.

THE FIRM RESPECTFULLY DENIES THE REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT DUE TO MARKET DECLINE, SALES CHARGES OR INTEREST. THE CLIENT PURCHASED CAIBX IN 2003. IN 2009, A MUNICIPAL BUILD AMERICA BOND WAS PURCHASED PAYING INTEREST IN AUGUST AND

FEBRUARY. AT THAT TIME, THE CLIENT AUTHORIZED AN AUTOMATIC CROSS REINVESTMENT PROGRAM FOR INTEREST TO PURCHASE CAIBX. ONCE AUTHORIZED NO FURTHER AUTHORIZATIONS ARE REQUIRED,

EXCEPT TO CANCEL THE PROGRAM. IN APRIL 2011, BASED ON HYPOTHETICAL ILLUSTRATIONS FOR BOTH CAIBX AND TIBAX, THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR RECOMMENDED MOVING THE CAIBX POSITION TO TIBAX BASED ON ANNUAL TOTAL PERFORMANCE AND YIELD OF EACH OVER THE PRIOR 9 YEARS. IN MAY 2011, THE CLIENT ACCEPTED THE RECOMMENDATION, PLACED TRADES AND COMPLETED A DISCLOSURE LETTER OUTLINING HIS REASON FOR REPOSITIONING AS "IMPROVE YIELD, ADD MONEY MANAGER, IMPROVE PERFORMANCE." THIS LETTER ALSO DISCLOSED PAST PERFORMANCE DOES NOT GUARANTEE FUTURE

RESULTS. AN AUTHORIZATION TO CANCEL THE CROSS REINVESTMENT PLAN INTO THE CAIBX WAS NOT OBTAINED DURING THAT MEETING. THEREFORE, TWO ADDITIONAL PURCHASES WERE AUTOMATICALLY EXECUTED IN AUGUST 2011 AND FEBRUARY 2012 AS STATED ON THE MONTHLY STATEMENTS. THE CURRENT VALUE OF THE POSITION

EXCEEDS THE TOTAL INVESTMENT VALUE AT THIS TIME.
