- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

BISCHOFF, HOWEVER, FAILED TO INVEST THE \$120,000 IN THE MANNER THAT THE CUSTOMER INSTRUCTED. RATHER, BISCHOFF DEPOSITED THE CHECK INTO A BANK ACCOUNT THAT HE HAD OPENED FOR HIS PERSONAL USE, UNDER THE SAME NAME AS THE ENTITY THAT THE CHECK WAS MADE PAYABLE TO, AND HE CONVERTED THE FUNDS TO HIS OWN USE. BEGINNING IN 2009, BISCHOFF SOLICITED SEVERAL FIRM CUSTOMERS TO INVEST IN A COMPANY, WHICH WAS NOT AN APPROVED INVESTMENT OF HIS FIRM. IN NOVEMBER 2009, BISCHOFF'S CLIENT INVESTED \$40,000 IN THE COMPANY'S CONVERTIBLE DEBENTURES, A SECURITY, VIA A PRIVATE PLACEMENT FACILITATED BY BISCHOFF. IN MARCH 2010, THE CLIENT SUBSEQUENTLY MADE A SECOND INVESTMENT IN THE COMPANY. ON OR ABOUT JUNE 6, 2010, BISCHOFF'S CLIENTS, TWO OF THEM, EACH PURCHASED 60,000 SHARES OF THE COMPANY'S STOCK FOR \$15,000 VIA A PRIVATE PLACEMENT FACILITATED



BY BISCHOFF. IN CONSIDERATION FOR HIS SOLICITATION OF THESE AND OTHER INVESTORS OF THE COMPANY, BISCHOFF RECEIVED 120,000 SHARES OF THE COMPANY'S STOCK AND WARRANTS TO PURCHASE AN ADDITIONAL 250,000 SHARES. BISCHOFF DID NOT DISCLOSE OR RECEIVE APPROVAL FROM ANYONE AT HIS FIRM REGARDING HIS PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPANY'S TRANSACTIONS. BISCHOFF FAILED TO RESPOND TO FINRA REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS.

**Regulator Statement**

DEFAULT DECISION RENDERED SEPTEMBER 27, 2012, WHEREIN BISCHOFF WAS FOUND TO HAVE CONVERTED CUSTOMER FUNDS, IN VIOLATION OF FINRA RULES 2010 AND 2150(A) AND FAILED TO PROVIDE DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION REQUESTED BY FINRA, IN VIOLATION OF FINRA RULES 2010 AND 8210, THEREFORE HE IS BARRED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY FINRA MEMBER IN ANY CAPACITY. IN LIGHT OF THE BARS, NO ADDITIONAL SANCTION IS IMPOSED FOR ENGAGING IN PRIVATE PLACEMENT SECURITIES TRANSACTIONS WITHOUT PROVIDING WRITTEN NOTICE TO HIS FIRM OR RECEIVING WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM HIS FIRM, IN VIOLATION OF FINRA RULE 2010 AND NASD RULE 3040. DECISION IS FINAL ON OCTOBER 25, 2012.
