- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

Allegations: FINRA RULES 2010 AND 8210, NASD RULES 2110, 2310 AND 3110: RESPONDENT WILLIAM GREGORY SLONECKER EXECUTED UNSUITABLE VARIABLE ANNUITY CONTRACT REPLACEMENTS OR SWITCHES INVOLVING CUSTOMERS WITHOUT REGARD TO THEIR AGE OR FINANCIAL BACKGROUNDS AND RECEIVED \$85,000 IN COMMISSIONS FROM THE SWITCHES. SLONECKER'S CUSTOMERS RECEIVED NO SIGNIFICANT BENEFIT FROM THESE TRANSACTIONS BUT PAID SURRENDER CHARGES TOTALING APPROXIMATELY \$240,733.08, SUSTAINED NEW, EXTENDED SURRENDER PERIODS, AND IN SOME CASES PAID ADDITIONAL FEES. SLONECKER MADE FALSE ENTRIES IN HIS MEMBER FIRM'S ELECTRONIC ORDER-ENTRY SYSTEM AND ON VARIOUS DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE NEW VARIABLE ANNUITY PURCHASES, MISREPRESENTING THAT THE FUNDS USED TO PURCHASE THE NEW VARIABLE ANNUITIES CAME FROM A BROKERAGE ACCOUNT RATHER THAN AN EXISTING VARIABLE ANNUITY, MISCHARACTERIZING THE TRUE NATURE OF THE PAYMENT METHOD FOR THE VARIABLE ANNUITY SWITCHES, AND MISREPRESENTING THAT NO EXISTING VARIABLE ANNUITY CONTRACTS WOULD BE REPLACED IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF A NEW VARIABLE ANNUITY. SLONECKER FALSELY REPRESENTED TO CUSTOMERS THAT SURRENDER FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE SWITCHES WOULD BE COVERED BY THE BONUSES CUSTOMERS WOULD RECEIVE IN CONNECTION WITH THE TRANSACTIONS, WHEN HE KNEW OR SHOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT THE BONUSES DID NOT OFFSET THE SURRENDER FEES AND THE CUSTOMERS WOULD HAVE TO PAY ADDITIONAL FEES TO RECEIVE THE BONUS, AND FAILED TO DISCLOSE AND EXPLAIN TO CUSTOMERS ALL OF THE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH A SWITCH. SLONECKER MADE FALSE STATEMENTS TO HIS MEMBER FIRM, CAUSED HIS MEMBER FIRM TO MAINTAIN INACCURATE BOOKS AND RECORDS, AND FAILED TO COOPERATE WITH FINRA STAFF.
