BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- **What if I want to check the background of an investment adviser firm or investment adviser representative?**

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. Allegations: 8/1/08-3/31/09; CLIENT CLAIMS THE DAY HE RECEIVED HIS JULY 2008 STATEMENT HE CALLED HIS FA AND REQUESTED ALL OF HIS MONEY IN MUTUAL FUNDS BE EXCHANGED INTO THE MONEY MARKET FUNDS FOR EACH MUTUAL FUND. CLIENT CLAIMS AT THIS POINT HE HAD LOST \$115,317.11 SINCE THE PREVIOUS YEAR, SO HE WANTED OUT OF THE MARKET. CLIENT CLAIMS THE FA ADVISED HIM NOT TO WORRY, THAT THE STOCK MARKET WOULD COME BACK VERY SOON. CLIENT STATES HE INSISTED THE FA MAKE THE EXCHANGES BECAUSE HE DIDN'T WANT TO LOSE ANY MORE MONEY. CLIENT CLAIMS THE FA DID NOT FOLLOW HIS INSTRUCTIONS AND HE HAS NOW LOST OVER \$400,000.00. ARB: CLAIMANT CLAIMS THAT HE INVESTED FUNDS ON 2004 AND WAS SATISFIED WITH PERFORMANCE UNTIL 2007 WHEN HE INVESTED ADDITIONAL FUNDS WHICH HE ALLEGES WERE PARTIALLY INVESTED IN UNSUITABLE EQUITY MUTUAL FUNDS. STATEMENTS REFLECT THE BALANCE ON CLIENT'S ACCOUNT ON JULY 2007 WAS \$784,417. OUR RECORDS REFLECT SEVERAL WITHDRAWALS TAKEN FROM THE ACCOUNT BETWEEN THE PERIOD OF AUGUST 31, 2007 AND JULY 25, 2008, TOTALING \$64,348.40. ACCORDING TO THE FA, SHE SPOKE WITH THE CLIENT ON JULY 28, 2008 TO DISCUSS HIS CONCERNS WITH THE MARKET AND OIL PRICES. FA STATES SHE DID NOT RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS TO SELL OR EXECUTE EXCHANGES FROM CLIENT'S STOCK MARKET MUTUAL FUNDS IN TO THE CORRESPONDING MONEY MARKET FUND DURING THE CALL. OUR RECORDS INDICATE FA SPOKE WITH THE CLIENT ON MULTIPLE OCCASIONS BETWEEN JULY 28, 2008 AND FEBRUARY 2009. IN ADDITION TO THE MULTIPLE CONVERSATIONS WHICH TOOK PLACE BETWEEN THE CLIENT AND FA, THE CLIENT ALSO RECEIVED ACCOUNT STATEMENTS PROVIDING INFORMATION REGARDING THE INVESTMENTS HELD IN THE ACCOUNT AS WELL AS REFLECTING ALL ACCOUNT ACTIVITY. THEREFORE WE BELIEVE HAD THERE BEEN CONCERNS ANY REQUESTED TRADES HAD NOT BEEN EXECUTED IN THE CLIENT'S ACCOUNT, THE CLIENT WOULD HAVE CONTACTED THE FA IMMEDIATELY. IN LIGHT OF OUR REVIEW AND INVESTIGATION, ANY COMPENSATION RELATED TO THIS MATTER IS RESPECTFULLY DENIED.
