BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

Allegations: CLIENT STATES HIS LOSSES COULD HAVE BEEN AVOIDED. HIS ACCOUNT VALUE ONE YEAR AGO WAS \$178,911 AND TODAY IT IS WORTH \$97,148. CLIENT STATES HE TRIED TO HAVE HIS ANNUITY CHANGED TO FIXED FOR THE LAST 2 1/2 YEARS, HOWEVER, IR INFORMED HIM THE ANNUITY WOULD COME UP IN VALUE. CLIENT ALSO STATES HE RECEIVED A REPORT OF SHARES IN HIS OPPENHEIMER ACCOUNT AND CLIENT DID NOT KNOW WHERE THIS MONEY WENT. CLIENT LASTLY STATES HE RECENTLY STARTED RECEIVING DIVIDENDS FROM BONDS. CLIENT INDICATES PREVIOUSLY THESE DIVIDENDS WERE TO GO TO THE MONEY MARKET FUND, BUT INSTEAD WENT TO THE ANNUITY AND OTHER FUNDS. CLIENT BELIEVES HIS ACCOUNT WAS MANAGED POORLY.

Broker Statement

ACCORDING TO THE IR, SHE MET WITH THE CUST SEVERAL TIMES TO DISCUSS THE INVSTMTS HELD IN HIS ACCTS. THE IR STATED THAT THE DECISION WAS MADE TO CONTINUE HOLDING THE VARIABLE ANNUITIES INSTEAD OF SWITCHING TO FIXED ANNUITIES DUE TO THE SURRENDER CHARGES THAT WOULD HAVE BEEN INCURRED WITH THE CHANGE FROM VARIABLE TO FIXED. IR ALSO STATED SHE ADVISED THE CUST IT WOULD BE BETTER TO DO THE 1035 EXCHANGE WHEN THE SURRENDER CHARGES WERE LOWER. IR INDICATED THAT THE CUST DECIDED NOT TO INCUR THE SURRENDER CHARGES. IR STATED SHE ADVISED THE CUST THAT HE SHOULD FOLLOW HIS ORIGINAL INVESTMENT PLAN AND NOT TRY TO CHASE RETURNS. IR ALSO INDICATED THAT SOME CHANGES WERE MADE TO CUST'S INVESTMENTS AT THE CUST'S DIRECTION. IT ALSO APPEARS THAT SEVERAL LETTERS WERE SIGNED BY THE CUST ACKNOWLEDGING CHANGES IN INVESTMENTS IN THE PORTFOLIO. ACCORDING TO FIRM RECORDS, CHECKS FOR THE PROCEEDS WERE SENT TO THE CLIENT AT THE ADDRESS OF RECORD. AT THE TIME OF THESE TRANSACTIONS, THE CLIENT WOULD HAVE RECEIVED TRADE CONFIRMATIONS AS WELL AS STATEMENTS WHICH REFLECT ACCOUNT ACTIVITY. ACCORDING TO THE IR, THE SALE OF 3.592 SHARES OF OPPENHEIMER ON NOVEMBER 18, 2002, WAS MADE TO COVER THE \$30 ANNUAL FEE CHARGED TO THE IRA ACCOUNT. IR ALSO INDICATED THE DIVIDENDS ON THE CLIENT'S BOND FUNDS WERE REINVESTED IN MUTUAL FUNDS BECAUSE THE CLIENT STATED HE DID NOT NEED THE INCOME AT THAT TIME. THE DIVIDENDS WERE NEVER REINVESTED IN THE CUST'S ANNUITIES. IR ALSO STATED THE CUST LATER DECIDED TO HAVE THE DIVIDENDS SENT TO HIM. AFTER REVIEWING THE CUST'S ACCOUNTS, IT APPEARS THE INVESTMENTS MADE WITHIN THE ACCOUNTS WERE APPROPRIATE FOR THE STATED OBJECTIVES AND THAT THE INVESTMENTS WERE MADE WITH FULL DISCLOSURE TO THE CUST. WHILE THE FIRM UNDERSTANDS THE CUST'S DISAPPOINTMENT IN THE DECLINE IN VALUE OF THE INVESTMENTS, IT DOES APPEAR THE DECLINE IS DUE TO MARKET FLUCTUATION. IT APPEARS THIS ACCOUNT WAS HANDLED APPROPRIATELY BY THE IR AND, AS SUCH, THERE WILL BE NO ADJUSTMENTS MADE.
