BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.

- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:

- information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- **What if I want to check the background of an investment adviser firm or investment adviser representative?**

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. If your search is successful, click on the link provided to view the available licensing and registration information in the SEC's Investment Adviser Public Disclosure (IAPD) website at <https://www.adviserinfo.sec.gov>. In the alternative, you may search the IAPD website directly or contact your state securities regulator at <http://www.finra.org/Investors/ToolsCalculators/BrokerCheck/P455414>.

- **Are there other resources I can use to check the background of investment professionals?**

<b>Regulator Statement</b>	<p>HEARING PANEL DECISION RENDERED WHEREIN RUNYON IS FINED \$20,000, SUSPENDED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY NASD MEMBER IN ANY CAPACITY FOR 6 MONTHS, REQUIRED TO REQUALIFY AS A GENERAL SECURITIES REPRESENTATIVE AND AS A GENERAL SECURITIES PRINCIPAL, AND ASSESSED COSTS OF \$2,459.85. THE FINE IS DUE UPON REENTRY INTO THE SECURITIES INDUSTRY. HEARING PANEL DECISION APPEALED TO NAC JULY 7, 2004. NAC DECISION RENDERED MARCH 9, 2006 WHEREIN RUNYON IS FINED \$20,000, SUSPENDED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY NASD MEMBER IN ANY CAPACITY FOR SIX MONTHS AND REQUIRED TO REQUALIFY AS A GENERAL SECURITIES REPRESENTATIVE AND PRINCIPAL. THE NAC AFFIRMS THE HEARING PANEL'S ASSESSMENT OF COSTS OF \$2,459.85 AS TO RUNYON AND ASSESS APPEAL COSTS OF \$931.49 AS TO RUNYON. THE NAC FINDS THAT RUNYON ISSUED TWO FRAUDULENTLY MISLEADING RESEARCH REPORTS. NAC DECISION APPEALED TO THE SEC APRIL 12, 2006. SEC DECISION RENDERED FEBRUARY 20, 2007 WHEREIN THE SEC SUSTAINED THE FINDINGS OF VIOLATION AND SANCTION MADE BY NASD. THEREFORE, RUNYON IS FINED \$20,000, SUSPENDED FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY NASD MEMBER IN ANY CAPACITY FOR 6 MONTHS, REQUIRED TO REQUALIFY AS A GENERAL SECURITIES REPRESENTATIVE AND AS A GENERAL SECURITIES PRINCIPAL, AND ASSESSED COSTS OF \$2,459.85. THE FINE IS DUE UPON REENTRY INTO THE SECURITIES INDUSTRY. RUNYON MUST PAY \$3391.34 IN COSTS. THE DECISION BECAME FINAL APRIL 20, 2007. RUNYON'S SUSPENSION IN ANY CAPACITY IS IN EFFECT FROM MAY 7, 2007 THROUGH NOVEMBER 6, 2007.</p>
