- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

Allegations: Without admitting or denying the findings, Crossett consented to the sanctions and to the entry of findings that without his estranged wife's knowledge or consent, forged her signature on the application paperwork for a line of credit, presented the paperwork to a notary public, and falsely represented that his wife had signed it. The findings stated that the line of credit was approved, and Crossett then withdrew \$50,000 from the line of credit and used the proceeds to fund his business. Crossett's estranged wife learned of the line of credit, when she received paperwork concerning it. She complained to the member firm that she had not consented to, and had no prior knowledge of, the line of credit. However, Crossett's estranged wife did not experience any losses resulting from the line of credit and she subsequently ratified Crossett's decision to open the line of credit.

Firm Statement Representative's wife notified the Firm's parent company that signatures purported to be hers on loan documents between the parent company, as lender, and the Representative and his wife, as borrowers, were not hers, and that she did not sign nor enter into the loan on her own accord. The Firm conducted an investigation and the Representative admitted to signing his wife's signature on such loan documents and to representing it to a notary as genuine in order to have the loan documents notarized. In its investigation, the Firm also learned that Representative engaged in an outside business activity regarding a residential real estate investment without disclosing such activity to the Firm. At the time of filing this Form U-5, the Firm has not uncovered any harm to any Firm client as a result of Representative's actions.
