## About BrokerCheck®

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
  - information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
  - information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

**Broker Statement**

We joined Insigneo on 10/23/2025. Immediately after my hire date I started working with my clients to move over 100 accounts to my new Firm. Over 90% of my clients are based outside the US therefore much of the account opening was delivered and processed via email and other digital means. In November 2025 Insigneo determined that certain client documentation we had produced did not meet their standards and requested to remediate them which we promptly started doing. Insigneo also confirmed that all the clients had confirmed the paperwork. On 10/28/2026 Insigneo communicated to us that we were being discharged for not following the Firm's account opening and ACAT transfer policies and procedures.
