BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. Broker Statement

THE CLIENT'S LETTER INDICATED THAT THE CLIENT DID NOT WANT TO INVEST IN BANK STOCKS. FA HAS STATED HE DID RECOMMEND THE PURCHASE OF THE WASHINGTON MUTUAL, DISCLOSING IT WAS IN THE FINANCIAL SECTOR AND DID PROVIDE THE CLIENT WITH A WRITTEN OPINION OF THE SECURITY. FA AGREES THE CLIENT DID BRING UP THE TOPIC OF SELLING HIS MUTUAL FUNDS IN 2007, HOWEVER AFTER DISCUSSING THE MATTER WITH THE CLIENT ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS THE FA DID SELL THE FUNDS PER THE CLIENT'S INSTRUCTIONS. ADDITIONALLY, IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE FA INFORMED THE CLIENT THIS WAS AGAINST HIS RECOMMENDATION. FA ALSO STATED HE DID INFORM THE CLIENT THAT THE CLIENT HAD THE OPTION TO REPURCHASE THE MUTUAL FUNDS WITHIN 60 DAYS TO AVOID INCURRING ADDITIONAL SALES CHARGES. AS TO THE CLIENT'S NOTE REGARDING HIS INTENT TO PURCHASE SHARES OF ST. JOE CO. IN EARLY 2008, IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE CLIENT CAME INTO THE FA'S OFFICE WITHOUT AN APPOINTMENT. THE FA'S ASSISTANT INDICATED THE FA WAS UNAVAILABLE AT THAT TIME. BASED ON OUR RECORDS AND THE INFORMATION PROVIDED, IT APPEARS THE FA REQUESTED THAT THE CLIENT TRANSFER HIS ACCOUNT FROM THE FA'S OFFICE IN SEPTEMBER 2008 WHICH HAS NOT OCCURRED. THE FA AND OUR FIRM WANT THE CLIENT TO RECEIVE THE BEST POSSIBLE SERVICE FROM AN INVESTMENT PROFESSIONAL, ONE THAT THE CLIENT IS COMFORTABLE DEALING WITH ON A REGULAR BASIS; THEREFORE, WE SUGGESTED THAT THE CLIENT BE BETTER SERVED BY A DIFFERENT FINANCIAL INSTITUTION WITH AN OFFER TO REIMBURSE TRANSFER FEES. IN CLOSING, IT IS OUR BELIEF THE CLIENT'S ACCOUNT WAS HANDLED BOTH APPROPRIATELY AND PROFESSIONALLY BY THE FA THEREFORE, THE CLIENT'S REQUEST FOR LOSSES, MISSED GAINS AND MISSED INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES WAS DENIED.
