- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
  - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
  - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

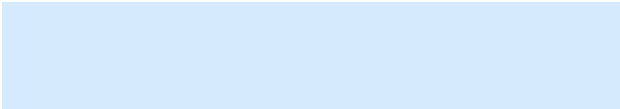

## Disclosure Events

**Allegations:** ATTORNEY FOR CLIENTS CLAIM THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR SUGGESTED THE LIQUIDATION OF THEIR ANNUITIES AND THE PURCHASE OF MUTUAL FUNDS WHICH GENERATED COMMISSIONS FOR THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR OF APPROXIMATELY \$12,000. THE MUTUAL FUNDS WENT ON TO PERFORM VERY POORLY AND THE CLIENTS LOST APPROXIMATELY \$145,000. ATTORNEY FOR CLIENTS APPEARS TO BE QUESTIONING THE ADVICE/RECOMMENDATION OF THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR. ATTORNEY MADE NO SPECIFIC MONETARY CLAIM.

**Broker Statement**

CLIENTS APPROACHED FINANCIAL ADVISOR INDICATING THEY DID NOT FULLY UNDERSTAND THE ANNUITY CONTRACTS THEY HAD PURCHASED FROM AN ADVISOR OUTSIDE OF EDWARD JONES. AFTER REVIEWING THE CONTRACTS, CLIENTS INDICATED THEY WISHED TO SURRENDER THE CONTRACTS. THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR ADVISED THE CLIENTS THE CONTRACTS HAD A CONTINGENT DEFERRED SALES CHARGED (CDSC) WHICH WOULD APPLY IF THEY SURRENDERED THE CONTRACTS. THEY WERE TOLD THE AMOUNT OF THE CDSC ON EACH CONTRACT AND ELECTED NOT TO WAIT ON THE SURRENDER OF THE CONTRACTS. THE CLIENTS EXECUTED PAPERWORK TO LIQUIDATE THE ANNUITIES IN APRIL 2007. AFTER THE SURRENDER OF THE ANNUITY CONTRACTS, THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR DISCUSSED THE REINVESTMENT OF THE ANNUITY PROCEEDS INTO MUTUAL FUNDS. THE SALES CHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PURCHASE OF THE MUTUAL FUNDS WERE DISCUSSED AND WERE SET OUT IN THE PROSPECTUSES PROVIDED TO THE CLIENTS AT THE TIME OF THEIR PURCHASES. THE CLIENTS RECEIVED THE APPROPRIATE BREAKPOINT FOR THEIR PURCHASE. THE CLIENTS ALSO RECEIVED TRADE CONFIRMATIONS AND ACCOUNT STATEMENTS AFTER THE MUTUAL FUNDS WERE PURCHASED REFLECTING THE ACTIVITY. AS PART OF THE TRANSACTIONS, AND TO ENSURE THE CLIENTS FULLY UNDERSTOOD AND TOOK INTO CONSIDERATION THE DETAILS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSACTIONS, THE FIRM REQUESTED THE CLIENTS REVIEW AND EXECUTE A LETTER ACKNOWLEDGING THE ANNUITY LIQUIDATION AND SUBSEQUENT REPOSITIONING OF THEIR ASSETS. THE CLIENTS CONFIRMED THE REQUESTED ACTIVITY IN WRITING AND VERBALLY INDICATED THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THE FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CHANGES TO THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR'S FIELD SUPERVISION DIRECTOR. THE CLIENTS ALSO WISHED TO TAKE SUBSTANTIAL MONTHLY WITHDRAWALS FROM THEIR ACCOUNTS AND EXECUTED AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT LETTER AT THE FIRM'S REQUEST FOR THE LARGE



ONGOING ACCOUNT WITHDRAWALS. BASED ON THE FIRM'S REVIEW, THE CLIENTS WERE FULLY INFORMED OF ALL DETAILS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSACTIONS, INCLUDING THE CDSC AND SALES CHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH THE ACTIVITY IN APRIL 2007. THEY FURTHER CONFIRMED THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF THE ACTIVITY THROUGH VARIOUS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT LETTERS AND DISCUSSIONS WITH A FIELD SUPERVISION DIRECTOR INDICATING THEY WERE MAKING INFORMED DECISIONS. WHILE WE UNDERSTAND THEIR DISSATISFACTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF THE FUNDS, THE PERIOD IN QUESTION WAS AN EXTREMELY VOLATILE TIME IN THE MARKET. THE MUTUAL FUNDS APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN WITHIN THE CLIENTS' STATED OBJECTIVES BUT WERE SUBSEQUENTLY LIQUIDATED AT THE CLIENTS' DIRECTION IN JANUARY 2009 DURING A SHARPLY DECLINING MARKET. EDWARD JONES RESPECTFULLY DENIES THE CLIENTS REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF LOSSES IN THE ACCOUNT.
