BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. THE FIRM HAS INVESTIGATED THE MATTER AND DETERMINED THAT INVESTMENTS IN THE CUSTOMER'S ACCOUNT WERE SUITABLE AND CONSISTENT WITH THE CUSTOMER'S INVESTMENT PROFILE ON RECORD AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE. ANNUAL PROFILE VERIFICATION LETTERS WERE SENT TO THE CUSTOMER SINCE AT LEAST 2008, AND NO CONCERN REGARDING PROFILE INFORMATION WAS RAISED BY THE CLIENT UNTIL 2015. THE FIRM HAS DISCUSSED THE MATTER WITH THE CUSTOMER AND THE CLIENT INVESTMENT PROFILE HAS BEEN UPDATED AS PER THE CLIENT'S REQUEST. THE FIRM SENT A WRITTEN RESPONSE TO THE CUSTOMER ON 1/21/16 ANSWERING EACH OF HIS ALLEGATIONS AND DENYING HIS COMPLAINT.

Alleged Damages Amount Explanation (if amount not exact): On December 18, 2015, I received an amended Form U5 from Citi International Financial Services ("CIFS"), where I had been a foreign associate. I am now in arbitration with CIFS, and am asserting substantial claims against that firm. On repeated occasions, my current firm's Chief Compliance Officer has attempted to verify that the "complaint" I am now reporting is, in fact, a bona fide, unsolicited complaint, and to obtain a copy of that alleged complaint. CIFS has ignored his requests for a copy of the complaint. I also wish to note that although CIFS admits that no compensatory amount was demanded by the customer, CIFS made up a number which I do not believe was made in good-faith. I believe CIFS did so as



part of a continuing campaign to harm my reputation in order to unfairly compete for business, I am reporting this complaint on my license without any ability to substantiate that what CIFS out on my amended U5 is accurate, and am doing so to comply with FINRA reporting requirements.
