BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- **What if I want to check the background of an investment adviser firm or investment adviser representative?**

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. - **Are there other resources I can use to check the background of investment professionals?**

**Broker Statement**

ON JUNE 15TH, I MET WITH CLIENT BECAUSE HE HAD A 100,000.00 CD COMING DUE WITH WELLS FARGO BANK. I PROFILED CLIENT AND FOUND OUT HE HAD OTHER INVESTMENTS OUTSIDE OF WELLS FARGO. HE TOLD ME THAT HE WAS AN EXPERIENCED INVESTOR WITH OVER 25 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE. CLIENT WAS LOOKING FOR SOMETHING TO PUT HIS MONEY IN FOR AROUND A YEAR OR MORE THAT HAD BETTER INTEREST THAN A CD. HE DIDN'T WANT TO PUT IT IN THE STOCK MARKET BECAUSE HE FELT IT WAS TOO MUCH RISK BUT WAS WILLING TO TAKE SOME RISK KNOWING THAT THE MORE POTENTIAL GAIN ON INVESTMENTS THE MORE RISK HE WOULD HAVE TO TAKE. AS I WAS GOING OVER THE DISCLOSURE DOCUMENTS, HE STOPPED ME IN THE MIDDLE AND SAID HE WAS WELL AWARE OF IT. I CONTINUED TO FINISH THE DISCLOSURES BUT WAS CONVINCED HE WAS WELL AWARE OF WHAT HE WAS DOING. I CONTACTED [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE] WITH WHOM I HAVE A JOINT REP CODE TO HELP [CUSTOMER] OUT SINCE THE CLIENT HAD \$175,000 TO INVEST. WE THOUGHT THAT THE HARTFORD FLOATING RATE FUND C SHARES WOULD BE SUITABLE FOR THE CLIENT SINCE HE PLANNED TO HOLD THE INVESTMENT LONGER THAN ONE YEAR, WAS AWARE OF THE RISK, AND HAD A YIELD MORE THAN A CD. BOTH OF US COUNSELED THE CLIENT THAT THIS INVESTMENT WAS A BOND FUND AND THAT IT CARRIED RISK, AS ALL BOND FUNDS DO. CLIENT CALLED ABOUT 2 WEEKS LATER WITH QUESTIONS ABOUT THE FUND THAT I COULD NOT ANSWER AND I TOLD HIM TO TALK TO [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE]. I ALSO ASKED [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE] TO GIVE HIM A CALL TO HELP CLARIFY ANY OTHER QUESTIONS THAT THE CUSTOMER MIGHT HAVE. FROM THAT POINT ON I WAS OUT OF THE PICTURE AS I DIRECTED ALL QUESTIONS ON TO [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE] AND LET [CUSTOMER] KNOW [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE] IS WHO HE NEEDS TO CONTACT. I FOUND OUT THAT THE CLIENT HAD SUBMITTED A COMPLAINT AFTER I WAS PROMOTED TO ANOTHER LOCATION AS A STORE MANAGER. THIS MADE IT HARD FOR ME TO CONTACT THE CUSTOMER BUT I WAS CONVINCED [OTHER FIRM EMPLOYEE] WAS TAKING CARE OF HIM.
