BrokerCheck offers information on all current, and many former, registered securities brokers, and all current and former registered securities firms. FINRA strongly encourages investors to use BrokerCheck to check the background of securities brokers and brokerage firms before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

- **What is included in a BrokerCheck report?**

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

- **Where did this information come from?**

- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

- **How current is this information?**

- Generally, active brokerage firms and brokers are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in CRD within 30 days. Under most circumstances, information reported by brokerage firms, brokers and regulators is available in BrokerCheck the next business day.

- **What if I want to check the background of an investment adviser firm or investment adviser representative?**

- To check the background of an investment adviser firm or representative, you can search for the firm or individual in BrokerCheck. - **Are there other resources I can use to check the background of investment professionals?**

Broker Statement

THE FA STATES HE MET WITH THE CLIENT IN MARCH 2010 TO DISCUSS HIS INVESTMENT NEEDS. DURING THE MEETING THE CLIENT INDICATED TO THE FA HE HAD SUFFICIENT FUNDS FOR HIS STANDARD OF LIVING AND DID NOT NEED ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR INCOME, BUT WANTED THE OPTION IN THE FUTURE. THE FA CLAIMS HE DISCUSSED VARIOUS OPTIONS, INCLUDING MUTUAL FUNDS, BONDS AND THE ANNUITIES WITH A DEATH BENEFIT AND INCOME RIDER. ACCORDING TO THE FA THE CLIENT STATED HE WAS INTERESTED IN THE GUARANTEES PROVIDED WITH A DEATH BENEFIT RIDER AND DID NOT NEED THE INCOME FROM THE ANNUITY. THE FA STATES HE RECOMMENDED THE PROTECTIVE VARIABLE ANNUITY AND DISCUSSED THE VARIOUS SHARE CLASSES AND FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONTRACT. THE FA STATES HE PROVIDED THE CLIENT WITH AN HISTORICAL ILLUSTRATION WHICH REFLECTED THE CONTRACT WOULD BE VARIABLE VS. FIXED, PROVIDED INFORMATION REGARDING THE UPFRONT SALES CHARGE, FEES AND HISTORICAL PERFORMANCE. THE FA STATES HE ALSO PROVIDED THE CLIENT WITH THE PROSPECTUS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ANNUITY. ACCORDING TO THE FA HE MET WITH THE CLIENT AGAIN A FEW DAYS LATER TO REVIEW THE INFORMATION AGAIN. THE FA CLAIMS, AT THIS TIME THE CLIENT AUTHORIZED THE SURRENDER OF THE CURRENT FIXED CONTRACT HE HAD ONCE THE SURRENDER PERIOD WAS OVER AND THE SUBSEQUENT PURCHASE OF THE VARIABLE CONTRACT. OUR RECORDS INDICATE THE CLIENT SIGNED ALL THE PERTINENT PAPERWORK NEEDED TO PROCEED. THE FA STATES HE PERSONALLY DELIVERED THE CONTRACT TO THE CLIENT IN APRIL 2010. THE FIRM FEELS THE CLIENT RECEIVED THE APPROPRIATE DISCLOSURES TO ALLOW THE CLIENT TO MAKE AN



INFORMED DECISION.
