FIC CONCLUDED THAT THE RECOMMENDATION WAS SUITABLE BASED ON HER INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES, HER INTENTIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE HANCOCK ANNUITY AND WHAT SHE WAS TOLD ABOUT HER ANNUITY AND ANNUITY RIDER. NEVERTHELESS. WE SENT HER A CHECK IN THE AMOUNT OF 10K AS AN ACCOMMODATION. HOWEVER, THE CLIENT DECLINED THE CHECK AND AFTER FURTHER DISCUSSIONS WITH THE CLIENT, WE AGREED TO SETTLE THIS MATTER BY, AMONG OTHER THINGS, WORKING WITH HANKCOCK TO REINSTATE HER ANNUITY I MET WITH [CUSTOMER] ON SEVERAL DIFFERENT OCCASIONS, SPENDING COUNTLESS HOURS TALKING TO HER ABOUT HER CURRENT SITUATION AND WHAT SHE WAS LOOKING TO ACCOMPLISH IN HER LAST COUPLE YEARS ON EMPLOYEMENT. SHE WAS ALSO UNAWARE THAT BY ANNUITIZING SHE WOULD LOSE THE POTENTIAL TO TAKE OUT A LARGE LUMP SOME OF CASH WITHOUT INCURRING ADDITIONAL FEES AND PENALTIES. SHE STRESSED THE FACT THAT THIS WOULD BE A PROBLEM. AFTER DISCUSSING THE OPTIONS SHE HAD WITH BOTH OF MY SENIOR MANAGERS AT FIRST INVESTORS.
