#### What is included in a BrokerCheck report?

  qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck
  reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the
  same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
  - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
  - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

Sentence/Penalty: I took a plea deal to have my charge reduced from Controlled Substance with no

Prescription (felony) to Soliciting Possession of a Controlled Substance (g. misdemeanor) and pied guilty on 02/14/2007. I was sentenced to 2 years probation, 365 days in jail with 364 suspended and a \$5,000 fine, with \$4,000 suspended. I paid \$518.92 on 07/09/2008 and \$681.08 on 12/10/2008. I violated probation with a new charge that doesn't fit the criteria for Question 14A(1)b and was ordered to pay an additional \$250 on 12/18/2008, which I did and then the

judge closed the case the same day.

Broker Statement On the night of August 5th, 2006, I was arrested for Controlled Substance with no

Prescription (felony). On this night, I was attending a party at my aunt's house and was in my car with a couple of friends and we Were getting ready to smoke marijuana. Apparently, one of my aunt's neighbors called in a noise complaint and when the police arrived, they saw my friends and I in my ??ar and decided to investigate us first. I had some marijuana on my lap when they shined a flashlight through my window. Since they saw what I had on my lap, t??ey asked us all to exit the vehicle so they could search it. Upon searching it, they found a bag with

more marijuana in

it. It was my bag, so I admitted to that and they placed me under arrest. I spent the night in the Snohomish County Jail that night and was released the following afternoon on my own personal recognizance. A\$ a couple side notes: (1). I was not sure how to complete two different questions of the charge details in the "Event and Disposition Details" section ("plea for each charge," the initial charge in my case and also disposition of amended or reduced charge), so I sought the advice of an attorney. I knew with certainty that the plea for my amended charge was "Guilty,? but wasn't sure about the initial charge and the clerk's office for the Snohomish County District Court, who has been providing "Ile all this case's detail wasn't sure how to answer this, so they are the ones that referred me to seek an attorney's advice. The attorney I worked with over the pho??e was able to look up my case and advised me that the plea for my initial charge was "Not Guilty" and instructed me to provide that answer in the "plea for each charge" field. This person also advised me that the disposition of amended or reduced charge in this case was "Convicted" and to select that option for that field. (2). The clerk's office for the Snohomish County District Court did tell me that my charge could be



classified as amended or reduced and that they mean the same thing. I mention this because in the "Disposition of Charge" section of my charge details, these are two different options.
