What is included in a BrokerCheck report?

- BrokerCheck reports for individual brokers include information such as employment history, professional
 qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards. BrokerCheck
 reports for brokerage firms include information on a firm's profile, history, and operations, as well as many of the
 same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
 - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
 - o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

Broker Statement I have never missed a payment in my entire life. I took a pay cut to come to Chase

to be a mortgage banker and because of the raising rates it dramatically effected my ability to earn. Over 75% of the staff in my specific department was laid off/left.

I love what I do here and was very successful.

I worked specifically in consumer home refinance. Business dropped off so bad that I was paying my bills with savings. I sent emails to my boss and her boss

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articulating that I was spending more money than I made by a lot to still work here.

I still never missed a payment. Before I missed a single payment I filed for bankruptcy because I had completely ran out of options. I made too much money to technically qualify for chapter 7 bankruptcy under what they called the means test but because of my situation, and because I did not miss handle my own finances. I was able to get my Chapter 7 discharged on 01/10/23 of this year.
