- o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- o information that regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against firms or brokers.

<b>Allegations:</b>	Without admitting or denying the findings, Holler consented to the sanctions and to the entry of findings that he engaged in a series of private securities transactions without providing notice to his member firm prior to participating in these private securities transactions, nor did he obtain approval from the firm. The findings stated that Holler solicited investors to purchase promissory notes in a purported real-estate investment fund. Ultimately, Holler sold approximately \$1.39 million in the promissory notes to individuals, nine of whom were the firm's customers. Holler received \$49,790 in commission in connection with these transactions. Holler also purchased approximately \$75,100 of the promissory notes for himself.
